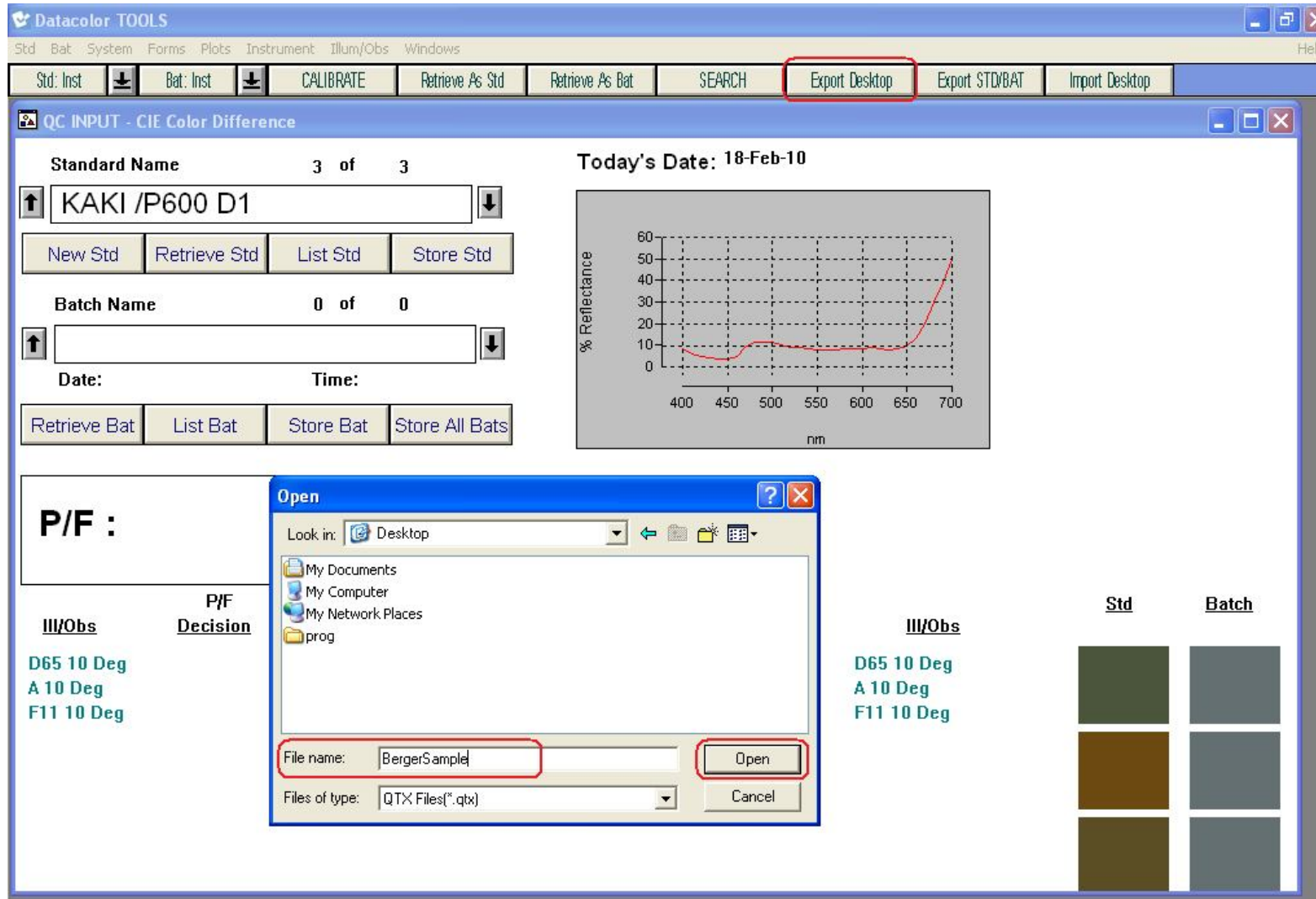


Here are instructions for exporting your TOOLS desktop to a QTX file

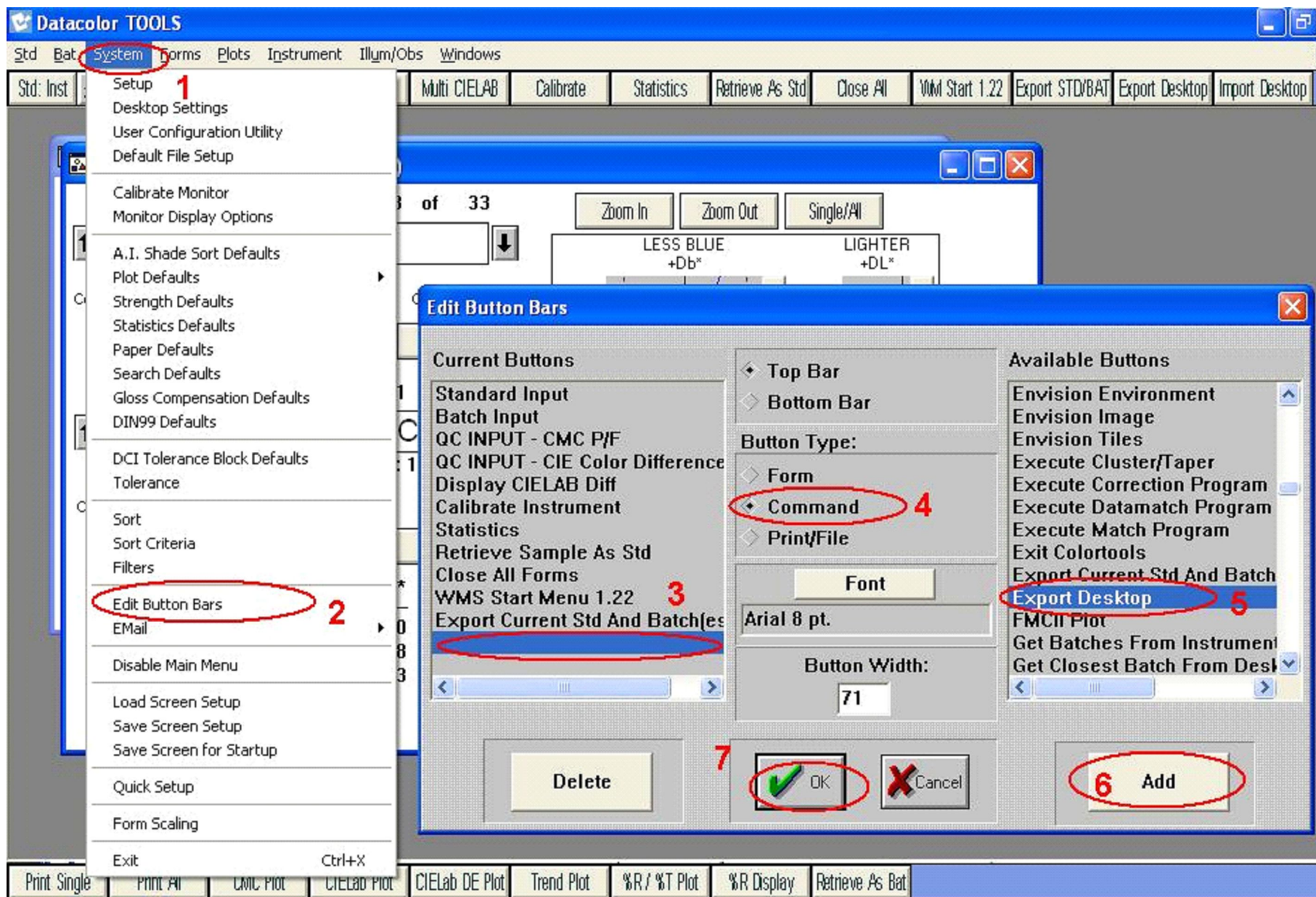
- 1) To export the desktop, click the button "Export Desktop" – see the picture #1



- 2) In the dialog that opens, select a location for the file (The Windows Desktop will work fine) #2 in the picture
- 3) Give a name for the file to be created (I used BergerSamples – see #3 in the picture)
- 4) Click the button “Open” (#4 in the picture above.)
- 5) Give the system a few moments to export the data, then look on your Windows desktop for the file that was created.
- 6) Attach that file to an e-mail and send it to me.

If you do not have the “Export Desktop” button, you can add it:

- 1) Select the menu, System
- 2) Select “Edit Button Bars
- 3) In the window that opens, select an open space in the section “Current Buttons”
- 4) Select the Button Type of Command
- 5) Scroll through the Available Buttons until you see “Export Desktop” and click on it to highlight
- 6) Click the button, Add (You will see the words “Export Desktop” appear in the list of “Current Buttons”
- 7) Click the button, OK. (You’ll see the export button in your top button bar.



Alternatively, it is also possible to use the FORM EDITOR utility to customize a screen form to display the command buttons, "Export Desktop" and "Import Desktop"

Installing the utility is optional. If it is installed, it will appear in your windows Start menu.
